Fantasy Football Stats Writeup 2024

1 Introduction

Congratulations to all on another great season! We made great strides this year with the development of the website, online roster submissions, and live scoring on our own platform. Thanks to everyone for bearing with us through various bugs and issues - despite some hangups, this season was hyper competitive and really fun.

This writeup provides a few stats that Turner and I found particularly interesting this season. There were a lot of close calls, interesting matchups, and surprising upsets, and it's exciting for us as commissioners to look back on the ups and downs.

For those who are in a rush, here are three quick stat takeaways for this season:

- 1. Tyreek Hill and Ja'Marr Chase were the two most rostered players, both rostered 25 times total thoughout the season.
- 2. Skid Marks dominated this season in total points. Both cumulatively and on average, he consistently had one of the highest weekly scores in the league.
- 3. While there were many interesting matchups, I would highlight the incredible matchup between The Good Guys and the Kingpins of Crime in Week 6. Incredibly, The Good Guys took this one by 0.02 points.

3 Roster Stats

This section provides stats related to how many times individual players were rostered in our league, combined with those that scored the highest. Tyreek Hill and Ja'Marr Chase topped the chart of most played fantasy players with an average of 24.57 and 24.40 points week to week. These titans were regular powerhouses, and teams won 64% of the time when they played one of these players.



Regardless of players rostered, most teams this season followed similar trajectories in terms of total points. In addition to performing well in cumulative points, some teams performed above average every week that they competed. The following graph presents the average total points scored by each manager in the weeks that they submitted rosters. No surprise - Skid Marks again took the top spot, and the Peach, Mario, and Luigi divisions dominated the highest average scorers.




Figure 3: Average Weekly Points by Team




Figure 4: Average Weekly Points by Division




Figure 5: Mario Division Total Wins per Week

Figure 6: Bowser Division Total Wins per Week




Figure 7: Luigi Division Total Wins per Week




Figure 8: Wario Division Total Wins per Week




Figure 9: Waluigi Division Total Wins per Week
